

2016 FCYC CRUISING STATION RULES AND PROCEDURES

“A Cruising Station is a Marina where FCYC members receive subsidized moorage”.

1. Cruising Station Agreements are in place with the following marinas:

1. Nanaimo Port Authority
2. Page’s Resort (Silva Bay)
3. Ladysmith Maritime Society
4. Ganges Marina
5. Mill Bay Marina
6. Port Browning Marina
7. Poets Cove Resort
8. John Henry Marina & Resort (previously Fisherman’s Resort and Marina - Pender Harbour)

2. Cruising Station Agreements cover the following topics:

1. FCYC members will receive subsidized moorage at the listed **Cruising Station Marinas**.
2. **Cruising Station Marinas** are designated preferred moorage facilities for FCYC members.
3. FCYC has provided to the **Cruising Station Marinas** a lump sum amount of money as a deposit, from which partial moorage fees will be withdrawn when FCYC members pay their account.
4. Rates charged by the **Cruising Station Marinas** are the regular Marina moorage rates.
5. 60% of the total moorage bill at the end of the visit, excluding utilities, but including taxes, will be payable by the club and charged to the FCYC account.
6. 40% of the total bill at the end of the visit, plus utilities and any other charges owed by the visiting boat, will be payable by the visiting member.
7. FCYC members will have the benefit of the Cruising Station program for a stay of two (2) consecutive nights, to a maximum of six (6) nights per calendar month.
-100% of the fees will be charged to FCYC members who stay longer than two (2) consecutive days, or more than six (6) days per month.

8. FCYC Members must show proof of 2016 membership and fly the FCYC burgee at all times while at the dock.
9. A register of FCYC visitors will be maintained by the Marina Managers, showing member ID number, name, boat name, number of days, how much was charged to the club, and how much was paid by the visiting boat. Members are to provide the required information upon arrival. Members are to request the FCYC Registration form from the Marina Managers if not immediately offered as part of the registration procedure.
10. Any cancellation fees, power, water and other miscellaneous charges are to the account of the visiting member, and are to be collected from the individual boater, unless any of these fees and charges are normally included in or are part of the regular moorage rates.
11. FCYC visitors will be required to make timely moorage reservations directly with all **Cruising Station Marinas**. If no reservations are made, moorage is only available at the discretion of the Marina.
12. Mooring space at the dock will be assigned by the Marina Managers in accordance with normal Marina procedures. However, **Cruising Station Marinas** are requested to moor FCYC members in close proximity when it is known that more than one FCYC boat is at their docks.
13. All cruising station agreements are in effect from March 1st 2016 until December 31st, 2016.
