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## **2019 RECIPROCAL MOORAGE**

### **RECIPROCAL MOORAGE INFORMATION** **FOR VISITORS**

Reciprocal guests to False Creek Yacht Club (FCYC) receive moorage free of charge for one 24 hours period per season, after which the preferred rate of \$1.25 per foot per day will go into effect. Utilities @ \$5 per day are extra.

Free stay is limited to one (1) night per season, i.e. Season 1: Spring/Summer (April through September) and Season 2: Fall/Winter (October through March).

Availability of reciprocal moorage is on a 'first come first served' basis and is dependent on open and vacant FCYC members' slips at the time of arrival.

Reservations may be accepted at the discretion of the Dock Manager, and if allowed, must be paid for by credit card at the time of reservation.

Reciprocal guests must present their current club membership card or a letter of introduction from their yacht club, and fly their club burgee at all times. Check in at the Marina Welcome Centre on VHF Ch.66A or telephone 604 648 2628.

FCYC is located on the North side of False Creek. The Welcome Centre is located on the long dock directly under the Granville Street bridge. Access from the dock to shore is keyless, but access to the dock from the parking lot is by key, which must be obtained from the dockmaster.

Washrooms, showers and laundry facilities are available on shore.

Reciprocal visitors are invited to make use of the club and lounge facilities on the third floor of the nearby building. Check [www.fcyc.com](http://www.fcyc.com) for further information; check 'Calendar' for lounge hours. The Clubhouse/Lounge is on the top floor of the three-story building under the Granville Street Bridge.

Other good restaurants can be found within easy walking distance, or just across the Creek on Granville Island. Ferry service for the short hop to the Island is a two minute walk from the Clubhouse. Groceries may also be purchased at the Granville Island Public Market.

### **Summary of FCYC reciprocal information for visitors**

- A visiting reciprocal member is required to fly their club burgee at all times.
  - Upon arrival visitors must register with the Welcome Centre, and present their current yacht club membership card, credit card information, and proof of minimum \$1,000,000 liability insurance. Debit cards are not accepted. Cash may be accepted but only if exact payment is made; there is no cash in the Welcome Centre to make change. Exact cash payments will be accepted to pay for Utilities and for Laundry tokens.
  - If unable to fly the reciprocal club's burgee, or if no yacht club membership card or proof of insurance can be presented, then reciprocal moorage privileges may not be extended.
  - Visiting yachts are entitled to one (1) night's free moorage per season. Utilities @ \$5 per day are extra.
  - Additional reciprocal moorage is available at a preferred rate of \$1.25 per foot per night. Regular visitor's rate is \$2.00 per foot per night. Utilities will be charged at a rate of \$5.00 per day.
  - False Creek and English Bay are considered "no dump zones". No dumping of holding tanks or any other substances is allowed under any circumstances. The pump-out station is available for free during the hours of 1000 and 1600.
- Shore facilities include restrooms, showers and laundry. Restrooms and showers are accessible by using the marina key. Laundry tokens may be purchased at the Welcome Centre or the FCYC clubhouse office.
- Visitors will be issued a marina key that must be returned to the Welcome Centre before departure. In order to obtain a marina key, credit card information must be provided. A fee of \$100.00 will be charged for keys that are lost or not returned.
